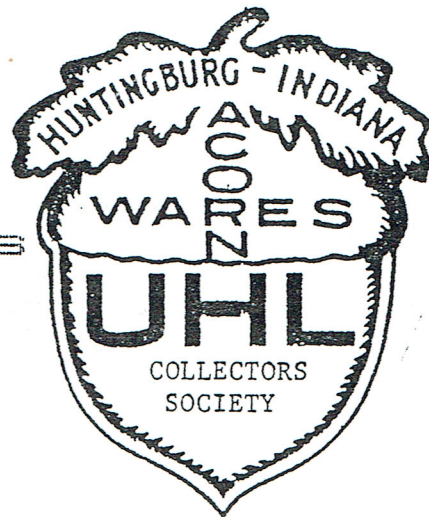

This news comes from President Steve Brundage, Vice President Dale Blann, Secretary/Treasure Tom Uebelhor, and Board of Directors. They met on Saturday January 30 1993 at the home of Steve in Hagerstown In. Much of the topic was about membership and commerative deadlines. We are a fast growing club and as of this news letter we are reaching nearly 350 memberships, with which most are husband and wife which puts us at nearly 600 members. We feel that some guidelines need to be established in order to run a fun and productive club.

TOPIC #1

Deadline for members to order a 1993 commerative is MARCH 31 !!!! This years price is \$20 if you plan to pick it up at the convention and \$27.50 if you wish to have it mailed to your home. All envelopes MUST be postmarked by March 31 no exceptions please.

You will be mailed a receipt by Tom Uebelhor by May 31 of which you MUST have in order to pick up your commerative. If you are picking up a commerative for a friend please bring along their receipt, this should keep things moving along smoothly an Saturday morning.

New members joining after March 31 will not be able to buy a 1993 commerative. They will have to wait and purchase a commerative next year. The only chance of getting a 1993 commerative may be at the meeting on Saturday morning when a drawing is held for the opportunity to purchase some of the extra commeratives.

Also old members will not be able to purchase a 1993 commerative if they don't renew membership and send in commerative money by the March 31 deadline.

TOPIC #2

The club is providing the Friday evening dinner and the Saturday morning continental breakfast free to members that have paid dues and returned reservations by the March 31 deadline. This is only good for the single name on a membership card or for the husband and wife which are named on a card. Anyone wishing to bring a friend or children must pay \$10 fee for meal tickets.

Old members and new that don't have their money and reservations in by this deadline period will have to pay \$10 per person for the Friday evening dinner and the Saturday morning continental breakfast.

The 1993 UHL COLLECTORS SOCIETY convention will be held on Friday June 25 and Saturday June 26 at the Holiday Inn in Jasper, Indiana. There are 75 rooms set aside for club members at a special rate, outside rooms are \$49 and poolside \$59. 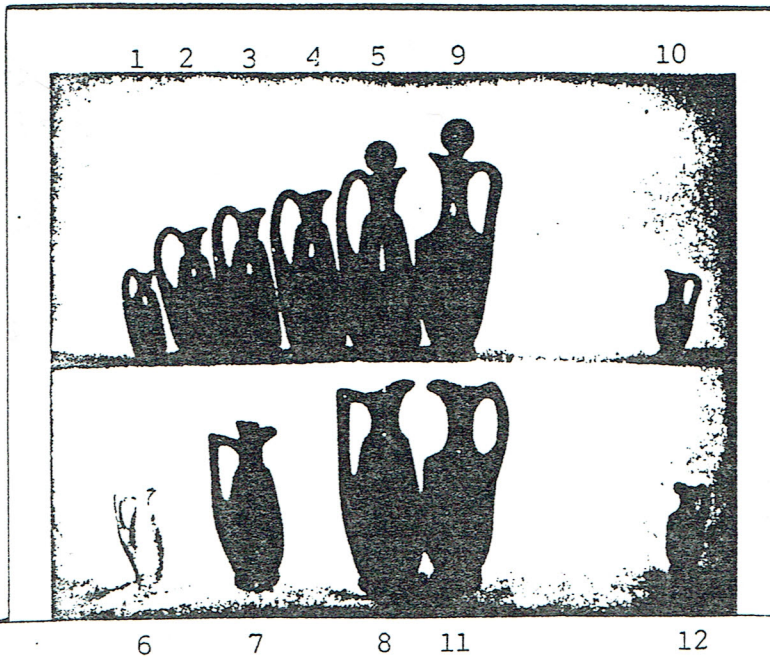

The Egyptian and Grecian Jugs have always been a mystery to us. Just maybe the following information will be of help to Uhl collectors. We have the 12 pictured jugs in our collection and believe all are UHL. The 8 jugs on the left side of the picture are Egyptian (numbers 1 thru 8). Those on the right side are Grecian (numbers 9 thru 12). The top row of jugs have curved handles and the jugs on the bottom row have angled handles. All may be identified by the UHL incised number and they all have recessed bottoms. The last two statements are true for all but jug number 10 in the picture. It is identified as number 8 in the UHL Catalog. All those we have seen have a flat bottom and no incised number.

We have seen other similar jugs but they usually have a rather flat bottom and are larger in diameter for the same height. These are probably not UHL.

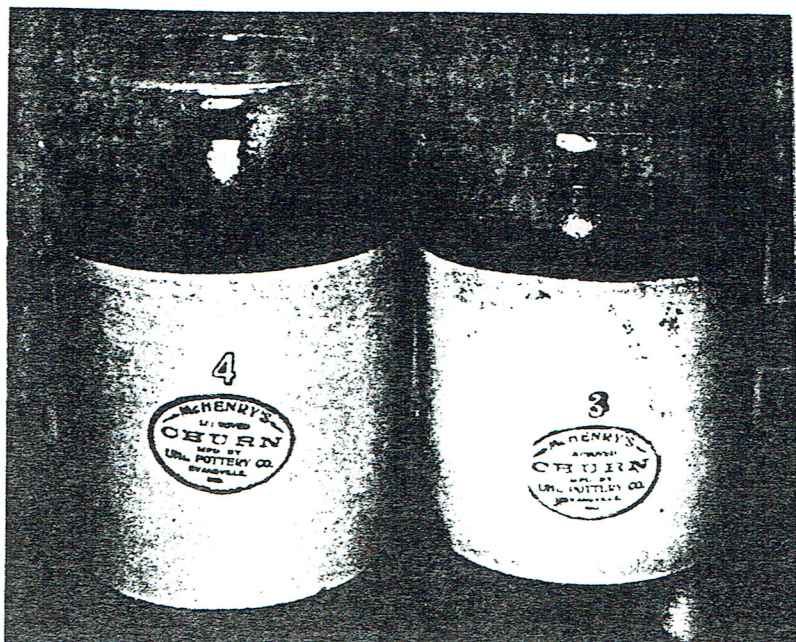
Did UHL make five different sizes of each type? There would be 20 different jugs if they did. We would like to hear from anyone who has information that would help solve our mystery.

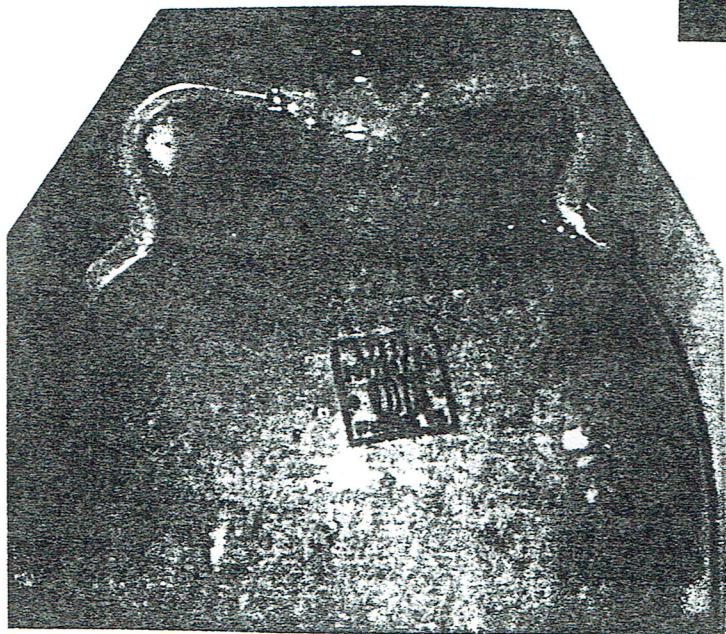
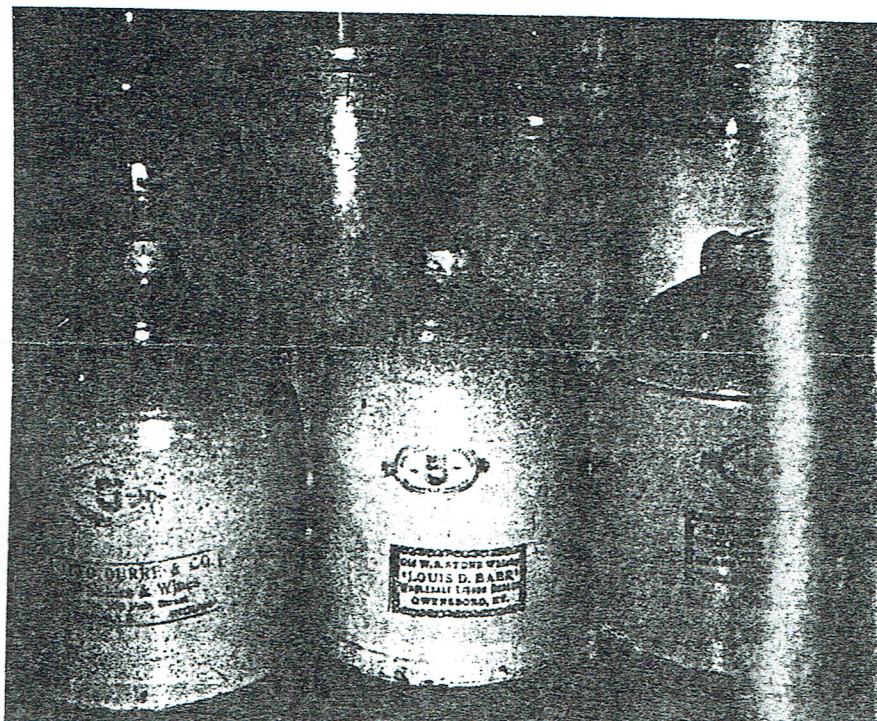
