Norman Spangler responded by requesting that Lloyd Martin and Father Erbacher be in charge of dessert for 2004 Convention.


A suggestion for a commemorative was a horse head in a larger mold than the original Uhl mold.


Jerry, as Leah had previously done, again thanked the volunteers and everyone that helped with the convention.



The Uhl Collector's Society is a not-for-profit organization open to anyone who is interested in Uhl Pottery and/or Stoneware.




