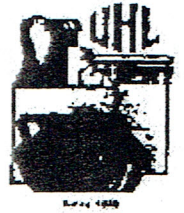

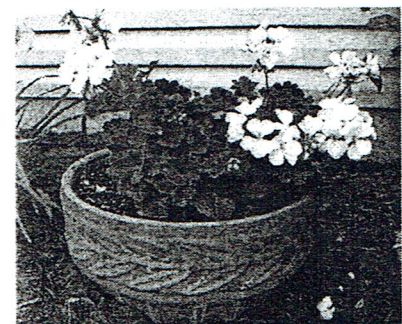


GET OUT YOUR GREEN THUMB

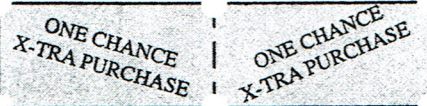
THE FOUR-POINT SCALE

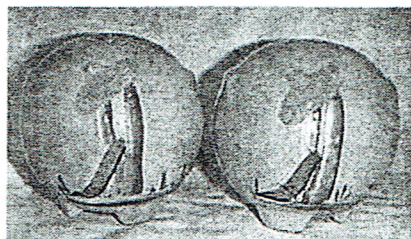
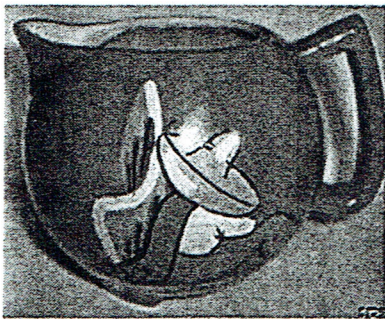

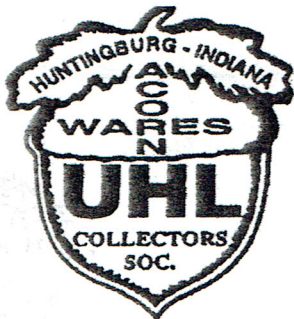
