



Dan had noticed that there was a small sticker on the bottom marked DH. It had once been a part of his collection, but that is only a small piece of the story.

In 1980 Dan was one of several collectors that had pieces photographed for the book A Collector's Guide & History of Uhl Pottery by Earl and Jane McCurdy. The jug is on page 40 the bottom left.


## \*\*\*Announcement\*\*\*

Twice since that publication the jug has been displayed at the Evansville Museum of Arts History and Science. The first exhibit was arranged by Earl McCurdy and there was a second exhibit at a later date. One thing is certain. The DH sticker will stay on my jug.

I asked Dan about the rare piece of Uhl, the Uhl Special 6. On December 31, 2020 on the Facebook page, I posted a picture from the March 1994 newsletter. That picture is below.

The marking reads: Uhl Pottery Works Special Six No. 17 of 1000 Evansville Indiana

I asked Dan if he knew anything about it. The answer was yes. In his time Dan had seen 2 Special 6's. One was pretty damaged and the other was not. He did not know much beyond that. What was "special" is probably lost in time. The rest of the story is that a member sold one of these on Ebay in February. Probably one that Dan had seen years earlier as it was quite damaged. Dan and I agreed that was a reasonable price even with the damage. Congratulations to the Chanley's as new owners of this great rarity! I hope to continue my conversations with Dan for a future newsletter. Thanks Dan!

### Another Uhl Mystery.....

If anyone that follows Uhl Pottery enough will find mysteries. One of the Uhl mysteries is brown stamped stoneware. We all know and love the common blue stamped crocks, but have you seen brown stamped Uhl? A two-gallon crock is shown in the Feldmeyer / Holtzman Uhl book. Pictured is a 3 gallon example from the Chanley collection. The origin of these pieces is unknown. If they were special order items, the question is why? The common belief / theory is that Uhl made these after the pottery ran out of cobalt blue. They then marked with common brown (Albany) glaze. If you have another theory, we'd like to hear it. If you have other brown marked items, please post the pictures! What is your mystery piece?
