The 1995 Convention has come and gone. A great time was had by most, with only a few minor problems that were easily worked out. For those of you that were unable to attend I hope the rest of the newsletter will fill you in.

The commemorative distribution started on Friday afternoon with many members in attendance. The blue and white churns are just wonderful, most people have told the

board members. A great deal of concern was riding on these churns because of the trouble the pottery had in producing them. Some of the stamps may not be very legible but they are still a nice shelf piece when the stamp is turned around. I was very pleased to be drawn for almost one of the very last extras, even if I can't read the stamp it sure looks good in my cabinet with our other Uhl. A total of 871 were produced this year.

The Holiday Inn conducted a very orderly dinner buffet for the 675 members that attended the Friday evening meal. I know the last table that was served probably may not think so, but all were served in about an hour with no mass confusion.

The members only auction started around 8:00 pm and lasted until 10:40 pm. Bidding was fierce at times, with some very nice items selling. Later in this letter you will find prices and some pictures from the auction.

Room to room socializing went on until the wee hours of Saturday morning. One room was very educational with some senior members showing us young learners about HAIRLINES, CRACKS, AND RING JUGS. Only those present may under stand all that was discussed that morning.

8:00 am Saturday morning the show and sale opened. The room filled very quickly with the mass flow of eager buyers. Many sellers said they had some very nice sales and enjoyed meeting some new faces. Also commemoratives were distributed again in a very orderly manner.

At 10:00 am the business meeting was held. This year a vice-president and a seat on the board of directors was to be voted on by the club. For vice-president we had two nominees, Roger Johnson from Pekin IL, and Joseph F Erbacher from St Anthony IN. By a show of hands Mr Erbacher was voted as vice-president for the next two years. 


