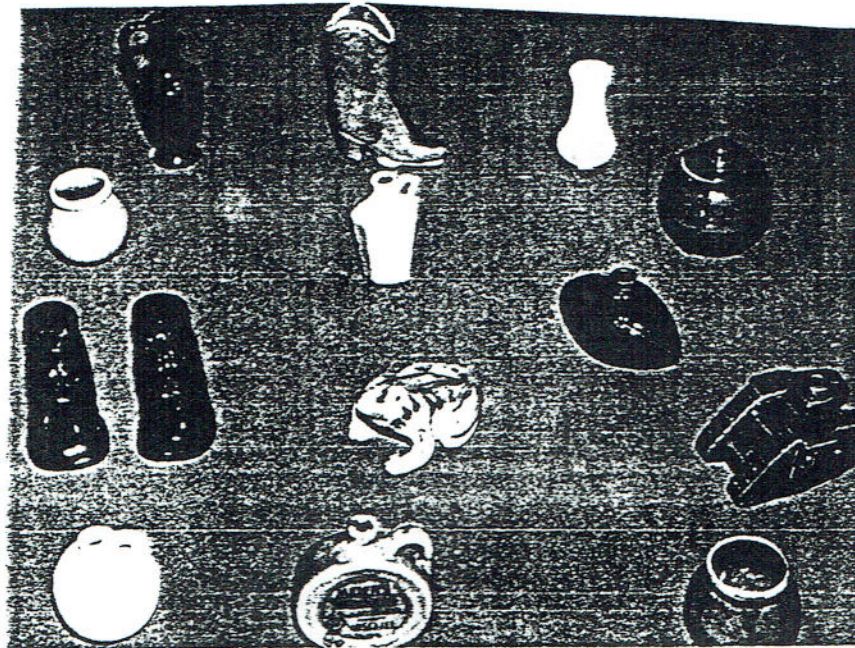

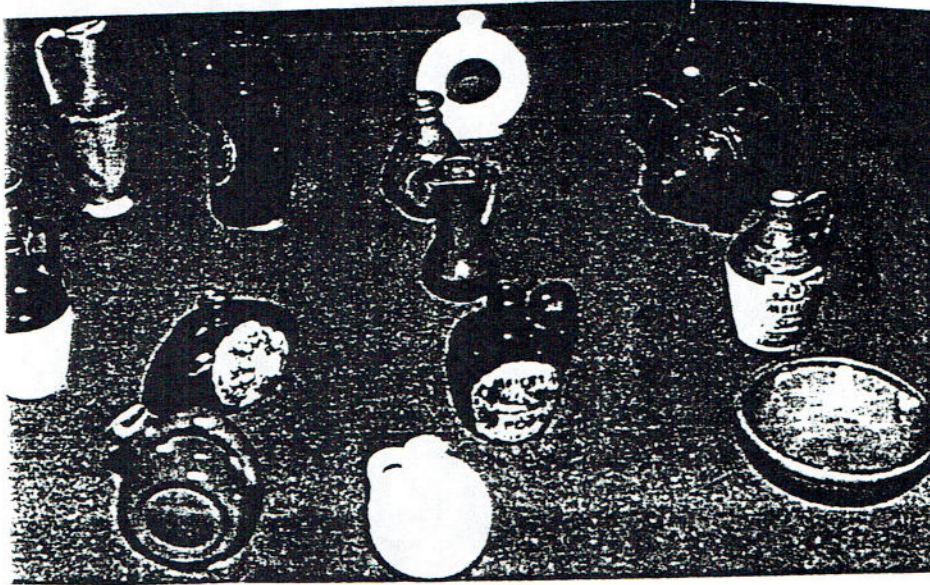

On April 1st a large auction was held with more than 300 pieces of Uhl and other stoneware. A new auction company held this sale and did a very good job for the single consignor. The Auction Company of Jasper has been around for a little over a year. During this time they have held two large Uhl auctions selling hundreds of pieces. They conduct a good clean sale and throw in a little fun at the same time. During this sale one of the auctioneers went into the crowd, knelt down and begged a bidder for another bid, and after the laughter gave his hat to the high bidder.

When it comes to Christmas jugs, earlier isn't always better. A 1943 brown and white shoulder jug with the Christmas paper label sold for \$1,400. This was the highest price for the day. 1937 Christmas jug with a chipped lip brought \$225, while a 1942 was \$300 and a 1941 went for \$325. A prunella "Greeting from Uhl Pottery" sold for \$305 and a bellied Christmas jug "Greetings from Uhl Pottery" sold for \$525, A Merry Christmas shoulder jug brought \$710, while a 1933 Christmas demijohn with a dark stamp sold for \$630.

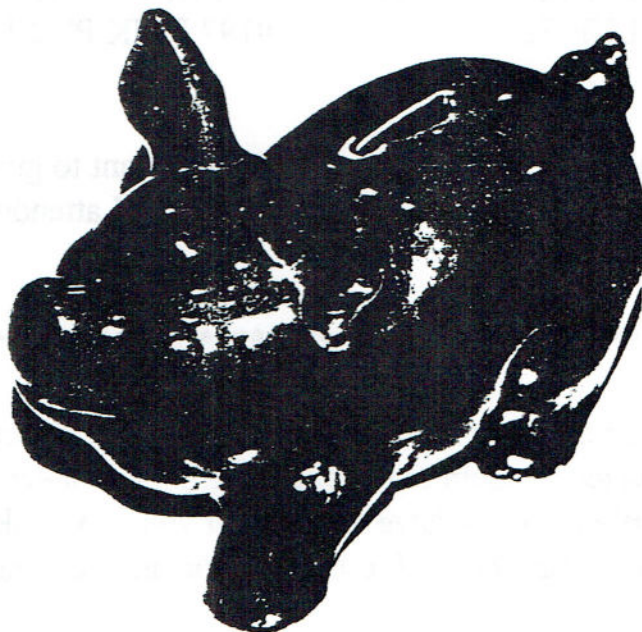


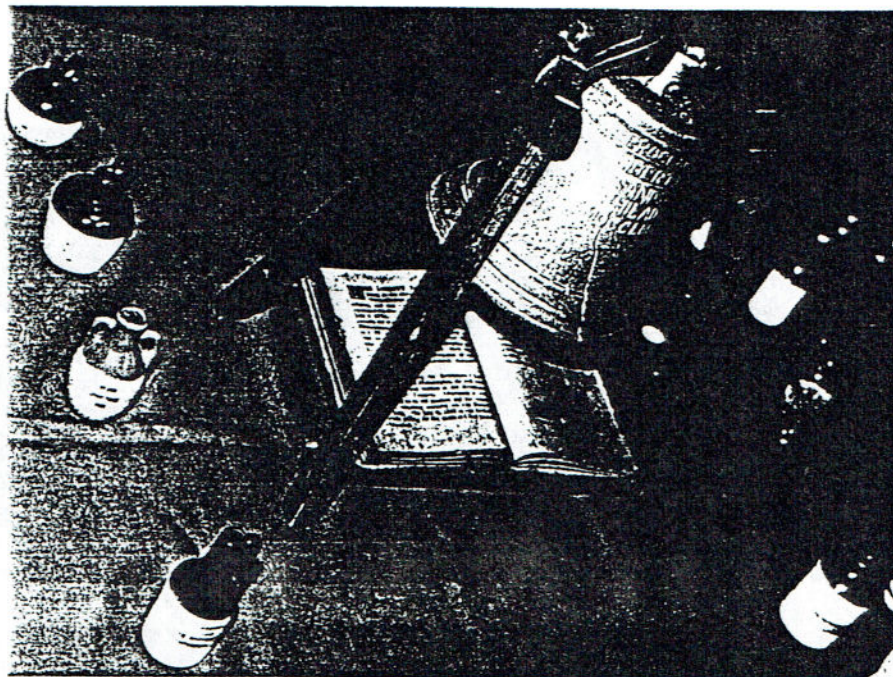
The pair of brown baby shoes above sold for \$80 while the smallest size frog brought \$150. Brown tank jug with Spring Mill State Park stamped on the bottom went for \$550 and a blue match holder topped out at \$380 while a white baseball jug only sold for \$55. A blue octagon jug \$90, brown football \$40, and a large blue cowboy boot (everyone was wondering if it was Uhl or not, because it was unmarked, and no one has seen a marked one) sold for \$130. Yellow #22 mini vase \$90, and a brown mini cookie jar sold for \$130.



In the above picture the brown pig bank sold for \$210, peach ring jug with a small chip on the lip \$75, small blue marked bowl \$310, pink grecian jug \$80, and most brown and white mini jugs sold from \$25 to \$55 and the higher priced ones had the Meiers Wine labels on them.

Below the purple large pig bank brought a good price! Although both of the ears had cracks running around them where they attach to the head and a crack running from the coin slot towards the tail. Would you believe a whopping \$350. The price for pork is still high in Dubois County no matter what shape it's in.





Above are the Christmas jugs that sold and also the liberty bell lamp which brought a very soft price of \$220.

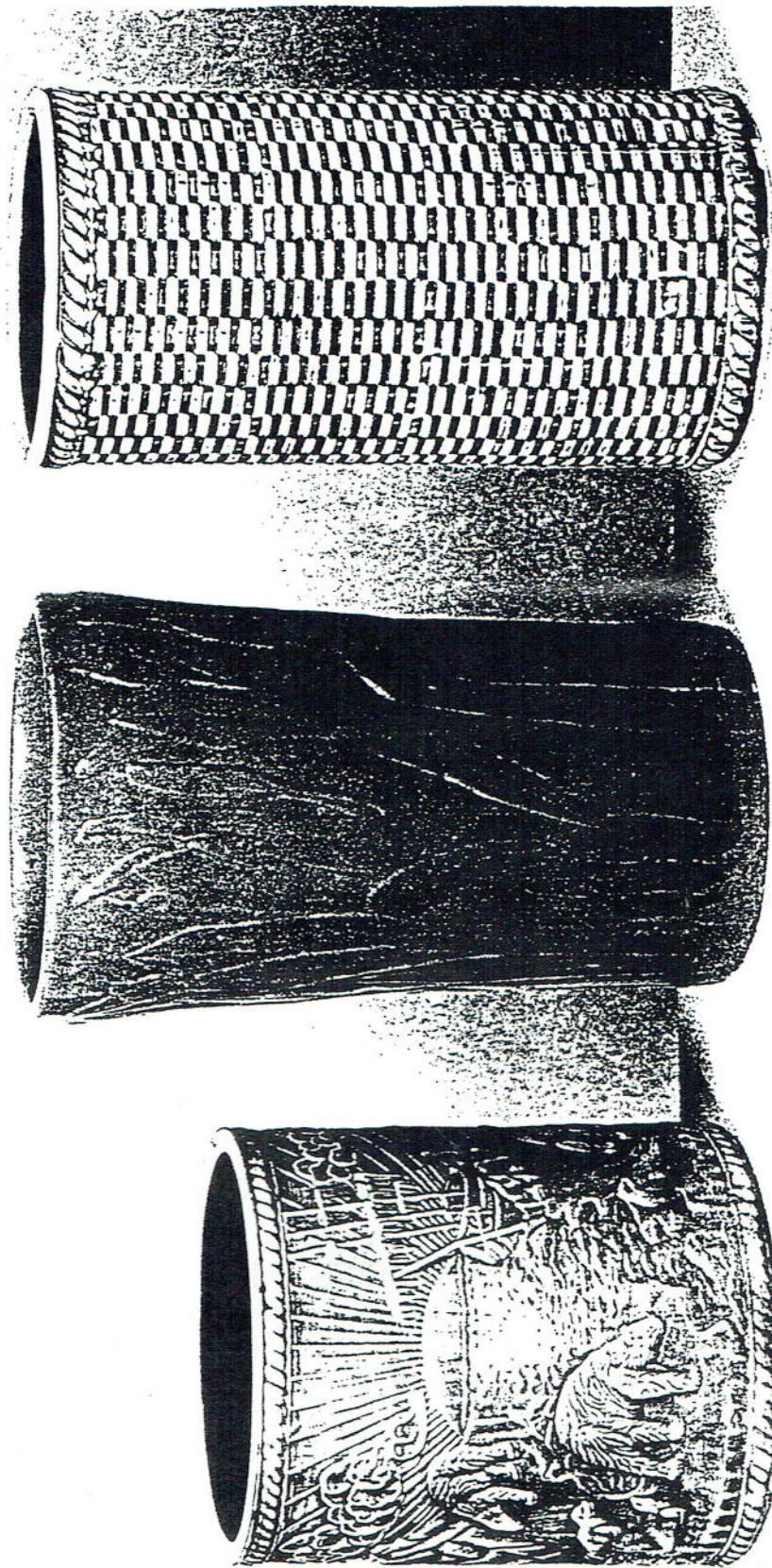
Thanks to newspaper releases and word-of-mouth from you, we have added several new members since the meeting in October. You will find an updated list of members included this month. Continue to get the word out.
