1998 UHL CONVENTION REVUE

The 1998 Uhl Collectors Society annual convention was held at the Jasper Holiday Inn on June 26 and June 27, 1998.

Several members came the evening before just to get an early start on the activities. Registration started at 2 PM Friday and continued while the auction registration was occurring. Members brought over 100 items to be offered at the evening auction. Auctioneers for the evening included Glen Hackman, Roy English and Chip Kugler. Special effort was made to call any defects on the sale items as they came up for sale. (Prices for this years Uhl Society auction are included in this newsletter.)

The evening dinner had 607 reservations made from the membership and the food was excellent.

Members were mailed the 1998 commemorative bean pots ahead of convention time so they would have them prior to their arrival at the site. This change worked very well and is expected to continue.

Throughout the day and into the late night people were wandering the rooms looking for those special pieces to add to their collection.

The Saturday morning Uhl sale held by the club members in the convention room had over 20 tables of items for sale.

President Joseph Erbacher opened the annual meeting with the financial report and minutes of the 1997 meeting presented by Secretary-Treasurer Elma A. and Beverly Leslie. During the meeting, discussion was held about the location for next year's convention and ways to locate those who have Uhl items for sale at the hotel.

Presentation of the special commemoratives to

the Uhl board members was given to Joann Smith, Beverly and Elma A. Leslie also Donna and Dave Swick.

Election of new board members included Elma A. and Beverly Leslie for secretary-treasurer and Dave and Donna Swick for press secretary both reelected for another 2-year term.

Filling the vacant position for board member of a 3 year term will be Gary and Diana Abel from Lynnville, IN. Joann Smith retired from the board this year.

The lottery for distribution of the extra commemoratives finished the regular meeting. This year 667 sponged bean pots were made. (Commemorative information from the proceeding years production is included in this issue.)
