- Jerry asked for ideas to improve the convention;

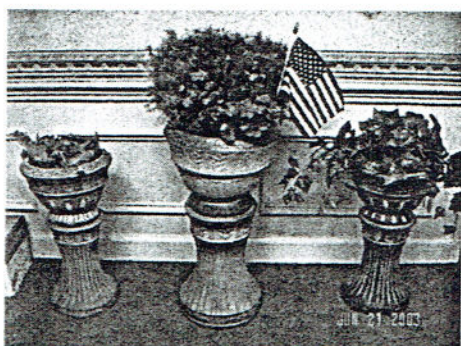
Norman Spangler responded by requesting that Lloyd Martin and Father Erbacher be in charge of dessert for 2004 Convention.

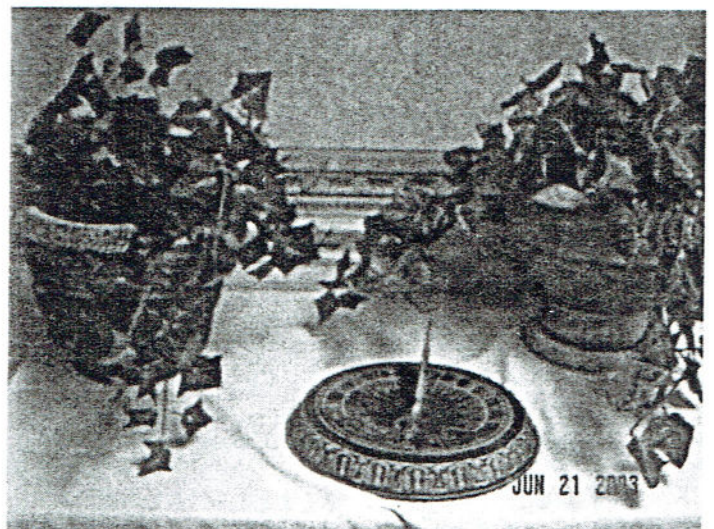

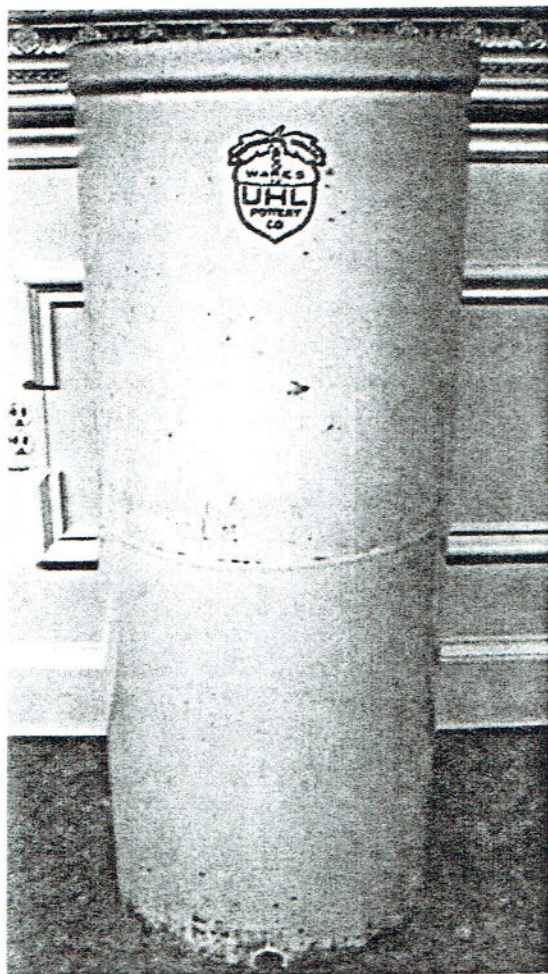
