#### Did You Know?

That one of UHL's best accounts was the Harper J. Ransburg Company of Indianapolis. UHL Pottery Co. furnished them with household items and flower pots that were glazed inside but not outside. They then decorated the outside with paint and different floral designs. UHL shipped approximately 1 to 2 truckloads per week. Ransburg Company eventually sold out to Hamilton-Cosco Co.

They also made thousands of liners for picnic jugs for the Royal manufacturing Company of Bowling Green, Ohio. These were also glazed white inside and outside of the neck. Royal put a metal covering around them with insulation between the two to keep food or drinks hot or cold.

A complete line of fancy and miniature jugs were made for the Meier Wine Cellars of Silverton, Ohio. They were used for packaging their various wine and cordials. In 1938 UHL received a certificate of award from Modern Packaging for the jugs furnished to Meier's.

During prohibition UHL shipped by rail car a SPE-CIAL 5 Gal. Jug to a dealer in Omaha, Nebraska. The dealer in turn sold these SPECIAL jugs to "Bootlegger". The SPECIAL part of the jug was that it was one-quart short of being 5 gal.

A line of miniature jugs and novelties was made for a perfume and cologne company in Kansas City named Botay. They bottled some of their products in the jugs, which were hand decorated. UHL also made them a line of piggy banks which were decorated and sold.

UHL was also able to sell all their broken ware to the North-western Terra Cotta Company who ground them up and used them in their terra cotta building materials. The broken ware which had not been glazed or burned was accumulated and sold to the American Art Clay Company in Indianapolis who made modeling clay for schools.

Of course they accumulated quite a few seconds which were chipped or off color. These were sold to peddlers who in turn traded them for eggs, chickens, fruit or vegetables. As we approach our 19th annual convention we have put together a list of local antique dealers in the Jasper-Huntingburg area.
