I would like to purchase the following items:

1. Ashtrays (pipe) 3 3/4" dia, and 3" dia. I prefer pumpkin color but would consider buying others. I prefer the 3" dia but would buy either size. The ashtray I am interested in is plate #230 in the Anna Mary Feldmeyer / Kara Holtzman UHL pottery identification & price guide second ed.
2. Also looking for ashtray 4 1/2" dia, with Masonic emblem. Ashtray is plate #169 in the second edition as well.

I was wondering if anyone knows how many different sizes, End of day Vases were made in? Reference to plate #271 in the first edition value guide.

I have the two of these vases which are 7 1/2" tall, and 4 1/2" dia and 7 1/2" and 2 1/2" dia in size. However about a year ago I viewed an UHL display at the Evansville Museum and I think there was a smaller vase. I would be willing to purchase a vase in a smaller size in the color gray.
