Articles & Board Member Information

News & Updates From Your President:

There was so much that I needed to say / inform the members about, I have written this "Information" article along with my Introduction and officer thank you article. I will keep things as short and informative as possible.

We had our fall Officers Meeting in September and voted on and are implementing things that were discussed at the Members Business Meeting back in June, on Saturday morning after the Convention.

As all of you realize, it takes Thousands of dollars a year to sustain the Club and host the yearly Convention. We are not in financial straits by any means, but to grow the Club and keep providing the things that are done for the members it is going to take money over the next several years. There has not been any increase of fees for several years and we need to make some changes.

First, starting in 2020, the dues are being increased from \$16.00 to \$20.00. Just to give an example of similar Clubs, The Red Wing Collectors Society charges a \$35.00 Membership fee per year and \$15.00 for a Spouse as an Associate Member. An increase to \$20.00 is not being out of line at all.

Second, we have charged \$9.00 per person for the meal at the convention, for several years also. The meal costs the club \$6.00 per person MORE than the \$9.00 you are charged. The club has been taking a \$6.00 loss per meal out of the clubs funds per person. We therefore have voted to raise the price of the meals at the Convention to \$15.00 per person which is just to break even. This next year there will be an additional charge for beverages paid on site. This was not our decision, but is part of the Huntingburg Event Center's rental agreement by the new owners. We are continuing to ask Members to bring desserts for the Dessert table. Everyone enjoys the diversity of available desserts! And YES, we made a FORMAL request that they move the tables away from the wall so folks can go down both sides of the tables. We are using the same company to provide the meals in 2020.

Third, we have voted to NOT raise the price of the 2020 Commemorative. We DID vote to give a Discount to those who wish to buy 2 Commemoratives. The price for buying one is still \$45.00. If you wish to buy 2, we will discount the price by \$5.00 each to \$80.00 for 2! There will still be a \$10.00 fee to mail EACH Commemorative if you choose to not pick them up at the Convention.

Fourth, The Club has opened a PayPal account. As me not only being President, but also Web Master, I will be integrating the PayPal account to the online Membership Form where you may pay your Dues & Convention Fees through PayPal! It will automatically send Alicia your filled out membership form along with acknowledgement that your fees are paid. PayPal charges us for this service and there will be an added fee to your charges for the convenience. You will still be mailed a membership Form in the News Letter or print it from the Website if you want to pay by Check through the mail.

Fifth, We read & listen to the suggestions we receive in the "Suggestion Crock" at the convention. In the next News Letter I will touch more on several suggestions next issue, but for now I will discuss one. One of our LARGEST costs is in your hands as you read this. Yes the News Letter. It is Hundreds and Hundreds of Dollars per year. More than one suggested to just email the News Letter. For those that remember I tested this earlier. The problem with using this as a money saver is the fact that not all members have email accounts. We still have to make and mail Hard copies to make sure all members are served. If EVERYONE had access to email, it would be a viable money saver. That being said, I have 90 email addresses available through the website! If those who do not have an email account, but have access to the internet want an email account, we can furnish you one free of charge! If every member had an email account, it would work as a great money saver for the club! Don't forget also, I have the Newsletter available on the Website as soon as it goes to print. Just click and read!
